La Vigne Educational House accepts learners from Grade R to Grade 12. We are a dual medium school that offers specialised teaching to learners with various learning barriers.

We adapt our classes and teaching style to meet the individual needs of the learners. Guidance is given to our learners to have a better understanding of the work, thus helping them feel more selfconfident and allowing them to take pride in their achievements.

We follow the CAPS syllabus as required by the Western Cape Education Department (WCED).

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SMALL CLASSES

With fewer learners per class, learners can connect more closely with their peers, becoming more confident and comfortable when sharing their ideas and perspectives.

Advantages of studying at La Vigne Educational House

Small Classes

With fewer learners per class, learners are able to engage more closely with their peers becoming more confident and comfortable when sharing their ideas and perspectives.

Our classes from Grade R to Grade 7 have a significantly low learner-educator ratio of 7:1; and Grade 8 - 12 with a ratio of 12:1 (dependant on the subject choices).

Advantages of a smaller classroom environment at La Vigne Educational House

- Learner barriers can be recognised and the necessary remedial assistance, intervention and support can be identified.
- Learners experience significantly less auditory and sensory disturbances.
- Educators are able to focus on the learner's different learning styles and individualise their feedback.
- Learners are able to engage, express their opinions and acquire a better understanding of the curriculum, enabling them to reach their full potential.

Therapists

When professional intervention is needed during school hours, we will accommodate all outsourced professionals. Please note the outsourced interventions will be at the parents' own expense.

Learner Support Classes

The Foundation and Intermediate Phase has a learner support educator who provides extra academic related intervention strategies to learners during school hours.

Parent - Educator Meetings

Each term we have our general parent / educator meetings where the learners' progress, interventions, suggestions and individual support plans will be discussed.

Extended school hours to assist learners with homework/intervention

Homework is an important element of the learners' education and it is necessary to reinforce the work that has been taught during the day.

We therefore have extended school hours in order to assist learners with their homework and possible areas requiring intervention. It remains the parents' primary duty to assist and support learners in tasks, assessments, prepared orals and examinations.

Computer Classes

Computer classes are offered during school hours. We teach learners how to use Paint, Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Power Point and how to do research on a topic.

Little Leaders (Skills and Lessons for Life)

Little Leaders is an emotional intelligence programme for Grade R - 3 learners. It is outsourced by professional therapists and is included in the school fees.





General Fitness Programme

The programme is aimed to help our learners become fit, healthy and improve their stamina.

Grade 1 to Grade 3 learners

This programme is not compulsory, although it will benefit each learner.

Grade 4 to Grade 9 learners

This programme is integrated in the physical education curriculum.

Tygerberg International Eisteddfod

We enrol our learners annually in the Tygerberg International Eisteddfod. They participate in poetry, debating, creative writing, handwriting and art. We give our learners the opportunity to compete against other schools in our area. We are proud to say that we have achieved competitive and promising results.



Special Events

At the end of each year we have a Prize-Giving ceremony; to boast with all our learners, celebrating and rewarding their excellent achievements.

PLEASE NOTE:

General School Rules

- Ensure that learners wear the correct school uniform and look presentable at all times.
- We ask parents to prepare healthy food snacks for their child's lunchbox every day. No sugar confectionery items are allowed, except on Fridays.
- Learners will not be allowed to be collected by any 3rd parties unless previously arranged with the school, with written consent from the parent.
- In the case of absenteeism, please notify the school no later than 08h00 on the day of absence. We need to keep record of all attendance. If your child is absent for longer than three days or missed a formal assessment, a doctor's certificate will be required.
- Learners must pursue their studies and school work with dedication, honesty and integrity.
- All electronic equipment including, but not limited to, cellphones, tablets, smart watches and electronic games/ toys are not permitted.
- Learners must attend school regularly and must attend all classes during the school day.
- Learners must respect other learners. No discrimination and/or bullying will be tolerated.
- We educate our learners to respect each other's individuality and uniqueness.
- Learners must respect all the personnel at the school.
- Learners must know, obey and respect the school rules as stated in the Code of Conduct.
